



Summer 2020 Reading Project For Incoming Second Graders

Welcome to Second Grade! Students are being asked to complete the following tasks over the summer:

1. Read at least 1 book from 3 different genres (a total of at least 3 books). We want you to select books that interest you; they could be fantasy, folk tales, mysteries, adventure stories, biographies, fiction, nonfiction, or animal stories. A list of popular books most incoming second graders enjoy is in the front of the Summer Bridge book as well as at the local library. You should select books that are appropriate for your reading level. Some of you are able to read small chapter books and others will enjoy shorter picture books. Remember that reading is meant to be something fun to do and you should enjoy the stories.
2. **Try to read every day for at least 15 minutes.** The time spent reading will be relaxing and will help you to be better prepared for second grade.
3. You are to select **one** of the books that you have read over the summer and make an informative and colorful poster about that book. Your poster will be displayed in the hallway; therefore, it is to be **no bigger than a half sheet of poster paper.** I want to be able to display all of the posters for everyone to see.
4. **The poster must have the book title and author, as well as illustrations about the story, at least 2 sentences about the story, and your name.**
5. Be creative with your ideas and materials!
6. **The poster is due by the end of the first full week of school, August 14, 2020.**
